RESOLUTION TO VACATE, IN PART, THE SIX (6) MONTH MORATORIUM ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE C.S. NO. 08-1741, AND ANY SUBSEQUENT EXTENSIONS THEREOF, FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF ALLOWING THE APPROVAL OF REZONING APPLICATIONS AND THE ISSUANCE OF PLAN REVIEW PERMITS ON MURPHY ROAD. (WARD 1, DISTRICT 1).

WHEREAS, to protect and preserve the health, safety, welfare and property of residents from the adverse impacts and safety hazards of increased traffic on LA Highway 21, North of I-12, it was necessary to impose a moratorium on the receipt of submissions by the Parish Zoning and Planning Commissions, for rezoning or subdivision of property, not previously applied for; and

WHEREAS, considering that the planned road construction project to address the increased traffic on LA Highway 21 has been completed and has alleviated the increased traffic on LA Highway 21 and Pinnacle Parkway, it is appropriate to allow for the receipt of rezoning applications and the issuance of plan review permits for 3.21 acres located on the corner of Murphy Road and Bricker Road more fully described in the attached Exhibits.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that pursuant to Chapter 2, Article XVI, Sec. 2-264 of the Code of Ordinances, the Parish Council vacates, in part, the moratorium established by Ordinance C.S. No. 08-1741, and any subsequent extensions thereof, to remove therefrom the restriction on the receipt of an application for rezoning and the issuance of plan review permits on 3.21 acres located on the corner of Murphy Road and Bricker Road. (Ward 1, District 1)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the moratorium shall continue to be in full force and effect as established by Ordinance C.S. No. 08-1741, and any subsequent extensions thereof.
