1)	016 Drainage - increase revenue transferred to capital and reduce the expenditure budget for District 9 to fund the costs of the Lowe Pond Erosion Control Project. (Per GASB 54, transfers are now recorded as reductions in revenues)
2)	017-25 Mental Health - \$200,000 Additional funding allocated for Suicide Prevention Programs.
2)	017-99 General Expenditures - \$50,000 Contract to review Operational Structure and Programs for DHHS.
