RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE WATER SAFETY COMMITTEE
CONSIDER ESTABLISHING A **NO WAKE ZONE** ON THE HWY
11 CANAL.

WHEREAS, the Hwy 11 canal is a narrow canal which also serves as the outfall for the Schneider Canal; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous homes and docks protruding into the canal thereby making the canal even more narrow; and

WHEREAS, any water craft traveling at an excessive speed would endanger not only themselves, but also personal property located along the canal; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government is charged with protecting the safety and general welfare of citizens of the Parish.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that the Parish Council requests the Water Safety Committee consider a "No Wake Zone" for the Hwy 11 Canal.
