RESOLUTION OF THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH COUNCIL
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS
FROM THE FHWA RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FOR
LOUISIANA (FRTPL), AS ESTABLISHED BY CFDA 20.219.

WHEREAS, the US Federal Government provides funds to the State of Louisiana for grants to state, local and non-profit organizations to acquire, develop and/or maintain motorized and non-motorized trails; and

WHEREAS, the FRTPL has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state and setting up necessary procedures governing project application under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of the application before the submission of said application;

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES that 1. Approve the filing of an application with FRTPL; and 2. Certify that the said applicant has or will have available prior to commencement of any work on the project included in this application, sufficient funds to build (including 20% local match), operate and maintain the project; and 3. Appoint the Parish Engineer as an agent of the St. Tammany Parish Government to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to application, letter of commitment agreement, amendments, payment requests and completion report, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
