RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING ST. TAMMANY PARISH THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO SIGN AND/OR EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF ELDERLY AFFAIRS REGARDING THE USE AND MAINTENANCE OF OFFICE SPACE IN THE TOWERS BUILDING.

WHEREAS, The Governor's Office of Elderly Affairs desires to use space in the Towers Office Building at 520 Old Spanish Trail, Slidell, Louisiana, 70458, (the "Towers Building"); and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government desires to allow the use of office space in the Towers Building in order to improve the safety and security of senior citizens living in St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, the cooperative endeavor agreement will be for eighteen (18) months from July 1, 2011, through December 2012, for eighty five (85) square feet on the sixth (6th) floor of the Towers Building.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Parish President is hereby authorized to sign and/or execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between St. Tammany Parish and the Louisiana Governor's Office for Elderly Affairs for the purposes stated above and to take all actions necessary, including entering into all agreements or negotiations in furtherance of the actions authorized herein; and

THAT all acts previously taken by the Office of the Parish President in furtherance of the actions or agreements contemplated herein are hereby ratified and approved.
