

The Department of Planning and Development recommends the installation of Signage to be installed in District 14.

As per MUTCD, when <u>signs with arrows</u> are used to indicate the restricted parking zones, the signs with the arrows should be set at an angle of not less than 30 degrees and not more than 45 degrees with the line of traffic flow in order to be visible to approaching traffic.


- 1. Install NO PARKING (Left Arrow) sign on the West side of S. Harrison Rd. 50' south of Highway 190, with sign facing North.
- 2. Install NO PARKING sign on the West side of S. Harrison Rd. 300' south of Highway 190, with sign facing North.
- 3. Install NO PARKING sign on the West side of S. Harrison Rd. 550' south of Highway 190, with sign facing North.
- 4. Install NO PARKING sign on the West side of S. Harrison Rd. 800' south of Highway 190, with sign facing North.
- 5. Install NO PARKING (Right Arrow) sign on the West side of S. Harrison Rd. 1035' south of Highway 190, with sign facing North.

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Figure 2A-2. Examples of Heights and Lateral Locations of Sign Installations




