Due to safety concerns with local school bus stops at this location, the Department of Engineering is not opposed to a council ordinance to place All-Way stop signs at the intersection of Ranch and Taylor.

Please consult legal counsel before drafting an ordinance or placing the Stop signs, as according to Louisiana Law; we must adhere to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). This is outlined in RS 32.235.
