The Department of Engineering recommends the installation of Signage to be installed in District 9.

As per MUTCD, when <u>signs with arrows</u> are used to indicate the restricted parking zones, the signs with the arrows should be set at an angle of not less than 30 degrees and not more than 45 degrees with the line of traffic flow in order to be visible to approaching traffic.


- 1. Raise and Replace CROSS CREEK BLVD. Street Name sign on Cross Creek Blvd. at the Cross Creek Blvd. and Highway 190 intersection.
- 2. Raise and Replace SPEED LIMIT 25 sign on Cross Creek Blvd. near the Hwy 190 intersection.
- 3. Remove No Outlet sign on Cross Creek Blvd. near the Highway 190 intersection.
- 4. Raise and Replace STOP sign on Clayton at the Clayton and Cross Creek Blvd. intersection as indicated on the map.
- 5. Remove STOP sign on Cross Creek Blvd. at the Clayton and Cross Creek Blvd. intersection as indicated on the map.

- 6. Raise and Replace STOP sign on Cross Creek Dr. at the Clayton and Cross Creek Dr. intersection as indicated on the map.
- 7. Raise and Replace STOP sign on Cross Creek Dr. at the Cross Creek Dr. and Cross Creek Blvd intersection as indicated on the map.
- 8. Raise and Replace NO OUTLET sign on Cross Creek Dr. near the Cross Creek and LaChenier Dr.
- 9. Raise and Replace SPEED LIMIT 25 sign on Cross Creek Dr. near the Cross Creek Dr. and LaChenier.
- 10. Install NO PARKING Sign (Left Arrow) on Cross Creek Dr. across from mailbox 117.
- 11. Install NO PARKING Sign (Double Arrow) on Cross Creek Dr. across from mail box 141B and 15' west.
- 12. Install NO PARKING Sign (Double Arrow) on Cross Creek Dr. across from mail box 145B.
- 13. Install NO PARKING Sign (Double Arrow) on Cross Creek Dr. across from mail box 161A.
- 14. Install NO PARKING Sign (Right Arrow) on Cross Creek Dr. 30'west of mailbox 168B
- 15. Raise and Replace all 3 STOP signs at the intersection of Cross Creek and Royston and add 3 ALL-WAY plagues to the stop signs.
- 16. Raise and Replace SPEED LIMIT 25 sign on Cross Creek Dr. near the Cross Creek and Leeds intersection.




Figure 2A-3. Examples of Locations for Some Typical Signs at Intersections

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Figure 2A-2. Examples of Heights and Lateral Locations of Sign Installations




C - MINOR CROSSROAD
