

WHEREAS, it is the desire of St. Tammany Parish Government to grant a servitude to Washington-Tammany Electric Cooperative, Inc. over, under and upon immovable property owned by Parish for to purpose of providing above and/or below ground electric services to the St. Tammany Parish Region Airport on Louisiana State Route No. 36 near Abita Springs; and
WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government has determined that it is in the public interest to entinto a servitude agreement for the purpose of providing electricity to the airport facilities; and
WHEREAS, a map defining the property on which the servitude is to be granted is attached here as Exhibit "A."
THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that it authorizes the Office of the Pari President to enter into a servitude agreement with Washington-St. Tammany Electric Cooperative, In for that certain property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto for the purposes of providing about and/or below ground electrical services to the St. Tammany Regional Airport on Louisiana State Round. 36 near Abita Springs.
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Office of the Parish President is authorized to exercits discretion in granting a servitude on this property, together with all agreements and transaction necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any and all actions previously taken by the Office of the Pari President to grant a servitude on the property are ratified and accepted accordingly.
REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shout affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this ethe provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Ordinance Administrative Comment

ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE PARISH PRESIDENT, TO ENTER INTO A SERVITUDE AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON-ST. TAMMANY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE TO THE ST. TAMMANY PARISH REGIONAL AIRPORT (WARD 4, DISTRICT 7).

St. Tammany Parish seeks to enter into a servitude agreement with Washington-St. Tammany Electric Cooperative, Inc. for the provision of electrical service to the St. Tammany Regional Airport located on Louisiana State Route No. 36 near Abita Springs. The present power lines have been deemed an obstruction to the flight zone by the Federal Aviation Administration. No compensation is being exchanged in conjunction with this servitude, as the servitude is needed to provide electricity to the airport and its facilities.
