The Department of Planning and Development recommends the installation of Signage to be installed in District 11.

- 1. Raise and Replace 4 STOP signs located at the Liberty and Jackson intersection and add ALL-WAY Plaques. Replace LIBERTY ST. Street Name sign.
- 2. Move existing No Outlet sign located near the Liberty and Jackson intersection to the top of the pole. Remove No Littering Sign from Pole. Replace No Littering sign with a NO PARKING EITHER SIDE OF THE STREET sign. Trim Bushes around pole.
- 3. Replace the LIBERTY ST. Street Name sign and the JEFFERSON ST. Street Name sign located at the Liberty and Jefferson intersection.
- 4. Install 2 LARGE ARROWS at the curve of Liberty St. and Jefferson.
- 5. Install a NO PARKING EITHER SIDE OF THE STREET sign on Jefferson, 100' from mailbox 59475.




