ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENT  
DRAINAGE CAPITAL - November 2012

Funds allocated for Schneider Canal Pump Station Improvements are being reallocated to Belair Retention Pond TMDL project and Labarre Street Retention Pond

Parish Administration is requesting the use of drainage funds (account 316-00) for the Belair Retention Pond Floating Wetland project. This project will not only address the new TMDL limits that are now required by EPA and LDEQ, it will increase the efficiency and efficacy of this pond as well as maintain capacity by reducing sediments in the water. Further, it will demonstrate a new water quality management technique that will be monitored upstream and downstream for a period of three years. Literature predicts that the contaminant removal efficiencies may be as high as 60% for this type of project.
