Appeal of Impact Fees - Building Permit 2012-5693

Please find the attached submittal by Walter Pennington, appealing the Mandatory Impact Fees for a Building Permit 2012-5693 in accordance with the Mandatory Impact Fee Ordinance.

"j. Appeal of exemption decision.

A Fee Payer affected by the decision of the Road Impact Fee Administrator (R.I.F.A.) regarding an exemption may appeal such decision to the Parish Council by filing with the Road Impact Fee Administrator (R.I.F.A.), within ten (10) days of the date of the written decision, a written notice stating and specifying briefly the grounds of the appeal. The Road Impact Fee Administrator (R.I.F.A.) shall place such appeal on the Council s agenda for the next regularly scheduled meeting. The Parish Council, after a hearing, shall affirm or reverse the decision of the Road Impact Fee Administrator (R.I.F.A.) based on the standards in subsections 5.a. through 5.g. above. If the Parish Council reverses the decision, it shall direct the Road Impact Fee Administrator (R.I.F.A.) to grant the exemption in accordance with its findings. The decision of the Parish Council shall be final." (emphasis added)

Similar language is part of the Drainage Impact Fees section.

Attached you will find all the information submitted by Mr. Pennington for the consideration as part of a request for relief in accordance with Section 2-009.00(B)IV.B.7 of the Parish Code.

Mr. Fontenot,

We recently received your correspondence regarding the required impact fees for permit #2012-5693. As I stated to you back in March, we feel that a great injustice has been done by the cancellation of our original building permit for this project without any written notification and necessary requirements to prevent that action. We were informed of the cancellation by our electrician after his request for the final electrical inspection earlier this year. To prevent an interrupution of the planned work of completing this project, we paid the requested permit fee for the issuance of a new permit not realizing this greater hardship requirement that would be next. Had we known back in March what would transpire, we would not have paid that fee and would have proceeded with the appeals process.

The purpose of this correspondence is to request two things from you. We have been advised to first pursue the appeals process through St. Tammany Parish. We need the requirements for starting this process. Second, assuming that this process will further delay the completion of this project, we need to know the payment options that you will agree to for the impact fees that would permit construction to continue (ie: 50% now with the balance due at building occupancy).

Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter to prevent additional interrutions of the project completion.

Mr. Fontanot,

We were issued a building permit in 2008 for an addition / renovation to our Christian religious tenter. The permit number was K07-1084F and the CP number was 06-06-105. The work on this project commenced shortly thereafter. We are in the process of completing this project after experiencing many unexpected delays.

Last week, our electrician completed his work and requested a final inspection. He was notified that our building permit had expired due to a period of inactivity which required completion work to be halted. He notified me of this problem and I immediately went to the permit office in an attempt to resolve this problem. However, I was informed that we would ply for a new permit to complete this project. During the permit process, we were informed that an impact fee consideration would have to be resolved before a new permit could be issued. No impact fee was required for the original permit due to the nature of this project. Though His expansion of our religious facility was much needed, had a fee been required, we would need have been able to proceed with this project because of limited funds.

I was instructed to send this fax to you for a waiver of impact fees for the new permit. The new permet number is 2012-5693.
