RESOLUTION DECLARING AS SURPLUS CERTAIN ASSETS
AND AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OR EXCHANGE OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany and Rodney J. Strain, in his official capacity as Sheriff of St. Tammany Parish entered into two Intergovernmental Agreements for the purpose of maintaining and improving the Hazardous Device Response Team and maintaining Hazardous Device Equipment, dated September of 2004, and March of 2006 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the terms of both Intergovernmental Agreements, and all equipment auditing periods have expired; and

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany no longer has any use for the various items of equipment and vehicle covered under the IGAs, and have deemed said movable property as surplus goods. A listing of the various movables is as follows:
