AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING FINALIZED SUBDIVISIONS INTO THE ROAD AND DRAINAGE INVENTORIES, SPECIFICALLY GRAND OAKS SUBDIVISION, PHASE 1A. (WARD 1, DISTRICT 1)

WHEREAS, Developer/Owner(s) have dedicated the rights of way to the public as indicated on the finalized subdivision plat recorded in the Clerk of Court’s Office.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: that all of the area within right-of-way, the road base, surface, drainage ditches, culverts, laterals, canals, and appurtenances thereunto belonging to or otherwise appertaining to the below indicated developments and authorized in the Resolution/Ordinance stated shall be incorporated into the Parish Selective Maintenance System.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all Parish regulations, policies, procedures and operating methods pertaining to the Parish Selective Maintenance System shall apply to the aforementioned developments.



Warranty Obligation (\$38,500)

Honorable Council Members:

The extended Warranty Obligation in the amount of \$38,500 expires January 5, 2018.

This office has inspected the site and the following work has been satisfactorily completed:

1. Crack filler has been applied to the asphalt roadways.
2. Roadside drainage has been restored.
3. Blue reflectors have been placed at the fire hydrants.
4. Fire hydrants have been elevated so that the nozzles are a minimum of eighteen (18) inches above grade.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Warranty Obligation be released at this time. This is a public access subdivision and the Parish is responsible for all maintenance as specifically outlined in the recorded plat file #5048. However, the twenty (20) foot Drainage Servitude between lots #47 and #48 will not be taken into the Maintenance System and must be maintained by the H.O.A. since the servitude is encumbered by fences.
