ORDINANCE TO DECLARE THE FORMER HIGHWAY 40 POLLING BOOTH/UNION GROVE RECREATION CENTER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PRIVATE SALE, PUBLIC AUCTION AND/OR DISPOSAL OF SAID PROPERTY DESCRIBED HEREIN (WARD 2, DISTRICT 6)

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish Government owns the property located at 21799 Highway 40, Bush, La, identified as 1.8 acres in Section 13, Township 5 South, Range 11 East, and being commonly known as the former Highway 40 Polling Booth and the former Union Grove Recreation Center (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is no longer needed for a public purpose, and there is a need and purpose to declare the Property as surplus and to sell, auction and/or dispose of said Property; and

WHEREAS, the Property will be sold in accordance with the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute 48:711, et seq.

WHEREAS, a survey and legal description of the Property are attached hereto.

THE PARISH OF ST. TAMMANY HEREBY ORDAINS: to declare 21799 Highway 40, Bush, La, identified as 1.8 acres in Section 13, Township 5 South, Range 11 East, and being commonly known as the former Highway 40 Polling Booth and the former Union Grove Recreation Center (the "Property") as surplus property no longer needed for a public purpose and to authorize the private sale, public auction and/or disposal of said Property.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED: that pursuant to all applicable provisions of law, the Office of the Parish President is directed and authorized to assess, deem, designate and determine that such immovable property is now surplus.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED: that the Office of the Parish President is authorized to exercise its discretion in selling, auctioning and/or disposing of this Property, together with all agreements and all transactions necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after adoption.


