

As per MUTCD, when <u>signs with arrows</u> are used to indicate the restricted parking zones, the signs with the arrows should be set at an angle of not less than 30 degrees and not more than 45 degrees with the line of traffic flow in order to be visible to approaching traffic.

- 1. Install 2 NO PARKING SIGNS (with arrows) on N. 13th St. 30' from the N. 3rd Ave. and N. 13th St. intersection as indicated on map.
- 2. Install 2 NO PARKING SIGNS (with arrows) on N. 13th St. 30' from the existing Slow Children @ Play sign as indicated on map.
- 3. Remove old Slow Children @ Play sign near the end of N. 13th St.
- 4. Install 2 NO PARKING SIGNS on N. 13th St. halfway between Jobs #1 and 2 as indicated on map.






Figure 2A-2. Examples of Heights and Lateral Locations of Sign Installations
