**Scope of Work/Services:**

Parish requires the Provider to supply and deliver 12.5% liquid sodium Hypochlorite (12.5 Trade Percent Available Chlorine) FOB destination in accordance with the American Water Works Association's Standard B-300-04 for hypochlorite to Tammany Utilities container sites (Attachment "A") as requested and determined by the Parish.

Deliveries to be made no later than forty-eight (48) hours after receipt of order. The delivery of the product must be done with an FRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic) tank truck with an onboard air compressor that delivers the product based on air pressure and requires no pumps or gravity. Packaging and shipment of product and placarding of delivery truck shall conform to the current regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation and other federal, state, and local requirements.

A Parish staff member will escort Provider to all delivery sites. Provider must contact the Parish one (1) hour prior to arrival at first delivery site of the day to schedule meeting with Parish staff for delivery. A Materials Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) shall be provided to each location of delivery of the Products before the delivery of the first shipment and again as amendments or changes to MDS are made.

Provider shall be responsible for the clean-up of any spills or overflows of Sodium Hypochlorite resulting from the delivery and filling Tammany Utility storage tanks.

The Term of the Contract will be two years beginning January 1, 2020, with the option for two (2) additional one (1) year periods, by written agreement of both parties. A notice of intent to renew would be issued in writing by the Parish.
