QUESTIONS & ANSWERS:

Question 1: It appears in the scope of work that once-a-week cleaning will require removing the full contents of the two lift stations.

Answer 1: No, we are amending the Scope of work to incorporate two types (Mayor and Routine) lift station cleanings.

Question 2: What is the advance notice time for scheduling a major lift station cleaning, and stopping flow to wet-well.

Answer 2: The parish will contact the provider a week in advance to schedule major cleanings. A Parish worker will be available to stop the flow to the wet-well for required major cleanings.

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Section 2.1 REVISED Scope of Work

PART II: SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICES

2.1 Scope of Work/Services

The Parish owns and operates two (2) large lift stations:

- 1. Castine Lift Station-Capacity 5,645 gallons with a diameter of 9ft and a depth of 14ft.
- 2. Faubourg Lift Station- Capacity 4,515 gallons with a diameter of 8ft and depth of 12ft.

Lift station cleaning will consist of two types of cleanings:

- 1. Major lift station cleaning- shall require pressure washing the walls of each wet well, floats, rails, piping/tubing, etc., and removing 100% of the lift station contents (wastewater, grease, debris, etc.) via vacuum truck. The Contractor will be required to transport this material for immediate off-site disposal to a site authorized by the appropriate regulatory agency. Major cleaning will be required every quarter or as needed. Parish will stop the flow to wet well for major cleaning.
- 2. Routine lift station cleaning- shall require full removal of surface floatables, once a calendar week or as needed.

All work is to be performed in compliance with all State, Federal, OSHA, and Contractor's safety standards. Likewise, any spills occurring as a result of lift station cleaning activities shall be cleaned and reported by the Provider in accordance with state and federal standards.

A Parish employee will be provided to guide and/or direct your operator/driver to all lift station locations. Additionally, the Parish will provide access to fire hydrants for wash water.

PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS:

The Contractor must provide the following:

- 1. Provide a price proposal sheet (Attachment A) to include a per cleaning rate as required for the Faubourg and Castine lift stations Major and Routine cleaning, to include all materials, tools, safety devices, operator(s)/driver, vacuum truck, pressure washer, disposal, and any other equipment or charges associated with cleaning lift stations at locations listed.
- 2. Declare the ultimate disposal site, and provide proof that the designated disposal site is authorized by the appropriate regulatory agency.
- 3. Proof that the Contractor is authorized by the appropriate regulatory agency to transport sewage waste.

- 4. Provide an inventory of the equipment (vacuum trucks, including size; pressure washers; etc.) that will be used to provide this service.
- 5. Provide qualifications, years in business, and experience providing the level and type of service specified in the proposal.
